Travis Rutherford stated they will need to have some more sand in the arena soon due to the weather this year. The rodeo club will be in Sunday and Monday to prepare the grounds. Tony Buzzetti stated the barn we locked down has been locked up for a month now and has been disinfected. Dick Harris asked about the roof on the concessions stand and Travis Rutherford reported that we still have one leak they will continue to try to get that taken care of. They will install a screen on the fan so things are not falling in there. Dick Harris reported on the gal from Walmart and Dick also talked to the guy who is in charge of the VFW post in Elko and he talked to her and she is suppose to do some painting at the grounds to give us the money. Larry also told Dick that they are giving us \$250.00, the basque club \$250.00 and the Silver State Stampede for \$250.00 this will give us another \$1,000.00 to help with suppression system.

They are selling only certain amount of tickets on this. He also reported condition books are done and have been mailed out and some have gone to Boise, Idaho falls, and the fair circuit in Idaho. Racing stalls will be taken care of between Fred and JJ. He talked to Lew Eklund and the Eklund family is on board for \$2,500.00 for their race. And he talked to Giovanni and Andrew on the Pucinelli claiming race and they didn't have any problems. He talked to Don Neuman and turned in appropriate paperwork to get some advertising money. He is going to set down and meet with Jim and Marv Morton to go over security on the fair and what has been done in the past.
