Dick asked about compromising to 3pm and do that with both weekends so they are consistent and he would like to give this a shot to see if it helps our betting. The board agreed this would be a good idea. Nancy asked about the admissions and when to start charging. ** Promotions Jim Elliott - hopefully tomorrow he can find out what money we are going to get from the Rec board this year. How are we going to handle bull riding tickets and the cost per adults and kids? Maybe start the bull riding at 6pm Agenda to the next meeting

** Stockhorse Tony Buzzetti - we got our cattle situation worked out and will have cattle provided by Ken Buckingham and the open branding and the co-ed will be raised on the entry fee to cover the cost difference all other class entry fees will stay the same. Stallion Stakes cattle are lined up and Dan Grailian will do the same on hay as last year. He will also be one of the branding judges.
