Entries will be received in the Flower Exhibit Building at the following times: 5:00pm – 8:00 pm, Thursday, SEE SCHEDULE OF EVENTS & GENERAL RULES! and 7:00am – 10:00am Friday. All entries are to remain until 4:00pm, Monday. Bring your claim check.

Judging:

Doors will be closed at 10:00am, Friday for Judging. Exhibits will open to the public at 2:30 pm, Friday.

General Rules:

1. All decisions of the judges shall be final. At their discretion, an award may be withheld even though it may be the only entry in the category.
2. Each exhibitor is allowed only one entry under each section number.
3. The Elko County Fair Board and Committee will exercise all care, but will not be responsible for loss or breakage of containers or accessories.
4. The Committee shall have the right to remove any exhibit which has become unsightly, to keep up the appearance of the Fair.
5. **Disposable clear glass containers are required, container must be marked underneath with the name of exhibitor and category number.** Use a container that is proportionally sized to the flowers. It contains. Such as: (small flowers in small container, etc.).
6. **Exhibits entered in the wrong category will be disqualified. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to read the schedule, follow the instructions and know what category each entry belongs in before bringing in your exhibits. Familiarize yourself with terms such as: grand flora, multiflora, double, single, bicolor, 1 spray, 3 blooms, etc. Also pay attention to the number of stems required.**
7. Foliage must be attached to all flowers except sweet peas, tuberous Begonias and Bells of Ireland. Please remove foliage below the water line in containers.
8. Exhibits calling for more than one stem should have stems cut the same length.
9. Exact number of specimens referred to in the Premium List must be adhered to – any quantities in excess of, or less than, the specified number may disqualify an exhibit.
10. Greenhouse plants must have been grown by the exhibitor or must have been in his or her possession for a minimum of four months.
11. Foliage must be clean, but not polished with oil or any plant preparation.
12. An exhibit with insects or disease will not be allowed in the competition and must be taken from the premises.
13. Juniors will be to the age of 17, and will be judged separately from adults.
14. Garden Club sponsored Displays are open to all exhibitors and are judged on an artistic and horticultural basis.

The Elko Garden Club will give a six-inch silver plate, to be kept by the exhibitor, to the most distinguished exhibit chosen from the arrangements and called "Best of Artistic Arrangements" according to the decision of the judges.

General Rules:

1. An exhibitor is permitted one entry per section number.
2. Fresh and dried plant material to be used in all arrangements. No artificial flowers, foliage or fruits may be used in this category.
3. Flowers and plant material may be self-grown or purchased by the arranger in Elko County.
4. A minimum of painted or treated plant material allowed.
5. All possible care of entries will be taken, but the Show Committee and the Fair Board will not be responsible for loss or breakage.
6. Each class will be judged separately.

These garden containers can be wood, clay pots, baskets, etc. The gardens must be planted by the exhibitor. Gardens may contain flowers, vegetables or foliage plants, annuals or perennials. Gardens must be established. Gardens may be entered by individuals, clubs or businesses. Only one entry per organization or individual per class. Gardens will be judged on creativity and condition. Exhibits with insects and/or disease will not be allowed in the competition and must be taken from the premises. These entries must not be too heavy to be moved easily. The gardens will be displayed throughout the exhibit buildings and will not necessarily be displayed together.
